HONORS for TRINITY LUTHERAN SCHOOL:

GOOD NEWS TO SHARE: This week our school received notification from the U.S. Dept. of Education that our school has been named a "Blue Ribbon School," a prestigious award signifying academic excellence and achievement. Across the U.S., 285 public schools were given this award and only 50 private schools were so honored. Trinity is among the 50! We are grateful to teachers, students, staff and parents who make this school a great place for faith and learning formation! In addition, Trinity is the only school in Hampton Roads recognized with an "International Baccalaureate" designation. The Blue Ribbon award will be bestowed on the school at a special ceremony in Washington D.C. in early November. What a great tribute. Way to go Trinity!
