Pastor Fred and Friel Guy are the proud grandparents of Liam Ryan Guy born on October 5th. More details and photos are posted on the church bulletin board.

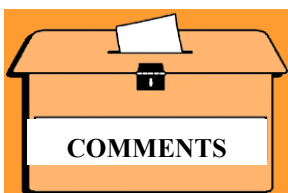

HONORS for TRINITY LUTHERAN SCHOOL:

GOOD NEWS TO SHARE: We recently received notification from the U.S. Dept. of Education that our school has been named a “Blue Ribbon School,” a prestigious award signifying academic excellence and achievement. Across the U.S., 285 public schools were given this award and only 50 private schools were so honored. Trinity is among the 50! We are grateful to teachers, students, staff and parents who make this school a great place for faith and learning formation! In addition, Trinity is the only **private** school in Hampton Roads recognized with an “International Baccalaureate **for Primary Years**” designation. 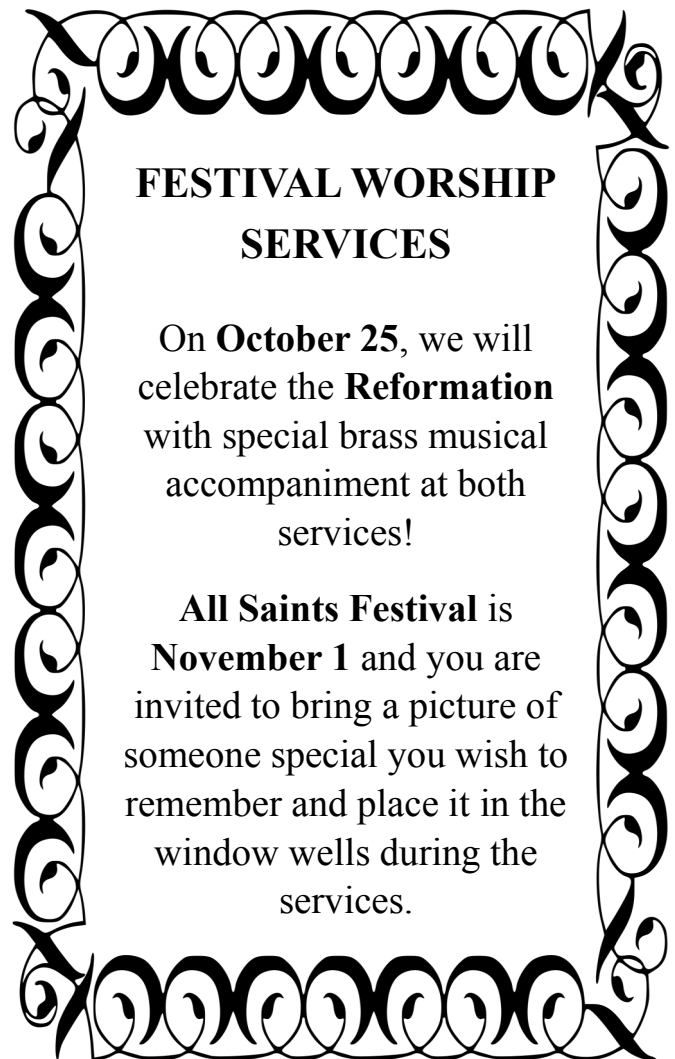
