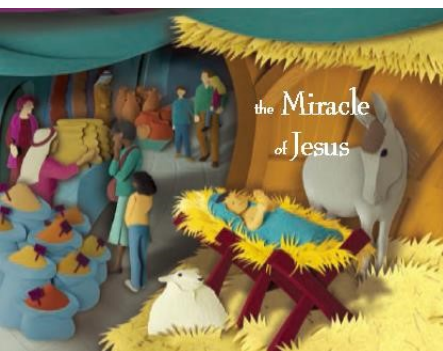
CONGREGATION MEETINGS:
