The very special invitation from Emet v'Or synagogue to share their Passover meal in our social hall on April 22 finds that today is the last opportunity for reservations. (see details in adjoining paragraph). This is such a special gift for three reasons: their invitation to us to share an interfaith experience; an opportunity to be included in a significant meal of our faith ancestors, and to participate in the heritage of our Lord's last supper with his apostles. Passover is the Jewish "freedom meal" as it remembers the exodus (from slavery and Pharaoh's oppression) as the people begin the journey to the promised land. It remembers the angel of death passing over the homes marked with the blood of the lamb. It recalls God's promise to preserve, provide and protect his covenant people. You're invited.
