ALL SAINTS SUNDAY: TODAY, we welcome seven members of the Virginia Symphony Orchestra, Elizabeth Vonderheide and Angelina Gandolfo, violin; Matthew Umlauf, viola; Rebecca Gilmore, cello; Christopher White, bass; David Vonderheide and Adam Gandolfo, trumpet who will accompany Trinity's chancel choir at 10:45 a.m. in a presentation of Bach's funeral motet *O Jesu Christ, meins Lebens Licht*, BWV 118, (O Jesus Christ, light of my life) written around 1736 or 1737. Matthew Umlauf, viola, will perform Hindemith's *Trauermusik* (Mourning Music) written in 1936 by Paul Hindemith on short notice in memory of King George V of the UK who had died the previous night.
