
# **TRINITY EVANGELICAL LUTHERAN CHURCH** Sixth Sunday of Easter 10:00 AM Worship Service • May 5, 2024

This Sunday's image of the life the risen Christ shares with us is the image of friendship. We are called to serve others as Jesus came to serve; but for John's gospel, the image of servanthood is too hierarchical, too distant, to capture the essence of life with Christ. Friendship captures the love, the joy, the deep mutuality of the relationship into which Christ invites us. The Greeks believed that true friends are willing to die for each other. This is the mutual love of Christian community commanded by Christ and enabled by the Spirit. Welcome members and guests to our worship service today. through the risen Christ, our source of living water, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, now and forever. Amen.







## PRAYER OF THE DAY

## FIRST LESSON: Acts 10:44-48

While Peter shares the good news of Jesus with a Gentile soldier and his family, the Holy Spirit comes upon them. Recognizing that the Spirit works inclusively in the lives of both Jews and Gentiles, Peter commands that these Gentiles also be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ.

While Peter was still speaking, the Holy Spirit fell upon all who heard the word. The circumcised believers who had come with Peter were astounded that the gift of the Holy Spirit had been poured out even on the Gentiles, for they heard them speaking in tongues and extolling God. Then Peter said, "Can anyone withhold the water for baptizing these people who have received the Holy Spirit just as we have?" So he ordered them to be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ. Then they invited him to stay for several days.

## SECOND LESSON: 1 John 5:1-6

By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God and obey God's commandments. For the love of God is this, that we obey God's commandments. Who is it that conquers the world but the one who believes that Jesus is the Son of God?

This is the one who came by water and blood, Jesus Christ, not with the water only but with the water and the blood. And the Spirit is the one that testifies, for the Spirit is the truth.





#### NICENE CREED






## THANKSGIVING AT THE TABLE

LORD'S PRAYER



## VIRGINIA HANDBELL CONSORT




